2026 Bulk Pick-Up Information

Clarkstown’s Bulk Pick-Up program helps homeowners dispose of the household items that appear on the Acceptable Household Bulk List.

Pick-Up Timeframe

Items must be brought to the homeowner’s curb **no earlier than the weekend before** the Bulk Pick-Up Schedule date and **no later than the night before** the scheduled pick-up.

- ◆ Refrigerators and Freezers (*single unit, doors removed*)
- ◆ Dishwashers
- ◆ Washing Machines
- ◆ Dry ers
- ◆ Water Heaters
- ◆ Room Air Conditioners

Limited quantities of:

- ◆ Sofas (1)
- ◆ Chairs (2)
- ◆ Storm/Screen Windows (10)
- ◆ Interior Doors (4)
- ◆ Carpeting and Padding (*tightly rolled/tied, less than 3 feet, 20 rolls limit*)
- ◆ Linoleum (*less than 6 feet width x 5 feet length x 3 feet high*)

Do-It-Yourself Home Remodeling Debris

Limited to (2) 5 foot bundle, less than 50 lbs. each

- ◆ Electrical Fixtures
- ◆ Plumbing Fixtures
- ◆ Plaster Board
- ◆ Wall Board
- ◆ Ceramic Tiles
- ◆ Scrap Lumber, Wood, and Paneling

Bulk Rules

- ◆ Total volume of bulk should not exceed 10 feet length x 6 feet width x 4 feet high (*excludes white goods appliances*). Loose items should be bagged or bundled.



Unacceptable Items Home Improvement Contractor Debris

Home improvement contractors who work on your home are responsible for removing all debris resulting from their work.

Electronic Recycling

Please note that electronic equipment, including televisions and computers, will not be picked up by the garbage carters. You may dispose of your electronic equipment at the Rockland County Household Hazardous Waste Site in Pomona **845.364.2444**.

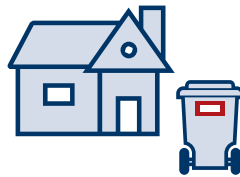
Collection Timing

Collection of household garbage is performed twice a week on the following two days: Monday/Thursday; Tuesday/Friday; or Wednesday/Saturday.



Collection Sticker

Each home (1, 2, & 3 family only) is issued one o cial garbage collection sticker by the Tax Assessor’s O ce. The sticker must be placed on the household garbage container. Additional stickers are available for a fee.



Garbage Container Placement

Our contract with the garbage carters provides for “side door pick-up” up to 125 feet from the street, or you may place your garbage containers on the curb. If you choose to place your container at the curb for pick-up, you are responsible for removing the container from the curb after pick-up.

Household Garbage Collection

Garbage Collection Rules

- ◆ **Collection Sticker On**
Only containers with stickers will be picked up.
- ◆ **Covered Container**
Each container must be covered.
- ◆ **Weight**
Containers cannot exceed 48 gal. or 60 lbs. of garbage.
- ◆ **Bagged & Contained**
All garbage must be bagged and placed inside the covered container.
- ◆ **Ready for Pick-Up**
Covered containers must be placed outside the night before the scheduled pick-up.
- ◆ **Removed**
Remove the empty container from the curb after each collection.
